

Dance Program Virtual Audition

Congratulations again on your admission to NSU Florida. We are so excited to welcome you to the dance program! Now that you're officially a Shark, we would like you to submit an audition video for course placement and also conduct an online interview during a Virtual Shark Preview Weekend. This audition process is required for all incoming dance majors.

How to Sign Up for Shark Preview:

- Check the email you used on your application for admission. Within one week of the date of your admission letter, you will receive a personalized URL to an online portal with additional instructions on how to sign up for a Virtual Shark Preview Weekend. You are encouraged to apply for additional Premier Programs that you can also interview for during Virtual Shark Preview Weekend.

What to Expect:

- Before your confirmed Virtual Shark Preview Weekend, prepare and submit a 1-2 minute solo video in the dance style of your choice to Elana Lanczi, M.F.A. at lanczi@nova.edu.
- During Virtual Shark Preview Weekend, you will meet with dance faculty via Zoom for a brief, informal interview to discuss your individual academic and artistic goals. The B.A. in Dance can easily combine with another major or minor, and you will have the opportunity to discuss your future career interests such as dance education, studio ownership, choreography, or dance therapy. The interview is an opportunity for the faculty to get to know you as well as an opportunity for you to address any questions you may have about the dance program.
- You will be assessed for level placement in dance technique courses during the audition.
- Please note that the interview is closed to observers.

Dress Code for Audition Video:

- Dance attire with solid colors is preferred. Long hair should be secured away from the face. Please no dangling jewelry or watches.
