Tech tips

How to join our RI Zoom sessions

Each RI session has an 11-digit number called a Meeting ID that will be required to join. Find the number on the RI schedule under Zoom Meeting ID.

See below for quick tips on joining the meeting from a computer, your mobile app, or telephonically.

<u>Important</u>: For participation confirmation purposes, when you join the meeting, make sure the display name is your actual first and last name. The Zoom sessions may have a waiting room function and your name is important so the session organizer can let you into the meeting.

On your computer or on your mobile device using the Zoom application:

To join a Zoom meeting on a computer or mobile device, download the Zoom app from Zoom download center: https://zoom.us/download

- Open the Zoom desktop (or mobile) application
- Click Join a Meeting
- Enter the Meeting ID from the RI schedule
- Please make sure the display name is your actual first and last name. Rename if needed.
- Select if you would like to connect audio and/or video
- Click Join

Telephonically, from a landline or mobile phone:

To join via telephone, you will need the teleconferencing number. Find the best number to call based on your location: https://zoom.us/zoomconference, e.g.

- On your phone, dial the teleconferencing number.
- Enter the Meeting ID from the RI schedule when prompted using your dial pad.

On your computer, from the browser:

- Open your browser, e.g., Chrome, and go to https://zoom.us/join
- Enter the Meeting ID from the RI schedule
- Make sure the display name is your actual First and Last name. Rename if needed.
- Select if you would like to connect audio and/or video
- Click Join
 - If this is your first time joining from a browser, you may be asked to open Zoom or the Zoom installer package. Follow prompts to open/install.

Parking Information

If you intend to park on campus, you will need to register your vehicle on the NSU Parking Portal. Please register your vehicle before coming to campus as we will be dispersing car decals to all registered students (Your login info is your NSU email and password).

Car registration is free for NSU students, so no additional payment to be able to park on campus. However, you will be required to pay to park if you do not have the decal.

For persons with a rental, a rental vehicle, they can register it on the parking portal as well. and check the box that says, "rental vehicle". Anyone with a rental does not need to place a shark decal on their car.

Driving Directions to NSU'S Main Campus

From I-95 or Florida's Turnpike

Exit at I-595; proceed west to University Drive exit. Turn left (south) onto University Drive. Proceed approximately 1 ½ miles to SW 30 Street (Abe Fischler Blvd.), turn left (east). NSU's main campus will be on the right side.

From University Drive

From North of I-595

Take University Drive south 1½ miles past I-595 to SW 30 Street (Abe Fischler Blvd). Turn left (east). NSU's main campus will be on the right side.

From south of Griffin Road

Take University Drive north approximately 2 miles past Griffin Road to SW 30 Street (Abe Fischler Blvd.). Turn right (east). NSU's main campus will be on the right side.

From I-75

From Miami heading north or west coast/Naples heading east

Merge onto I-595 eastbound (towards Fort Lauderdale). Exit at University Drive exit, turn right (south). Proceed approximately 1½ miles on University Drive to SW 30 Street (Abe Fischler Blvd.), turn left (east). NSU's main campus will be on the right side.

Access the Mailman Hollywood Building

Upon turning onto SW 30 Street, travel east. You will notice several entrances into the main campus on your right-hand side. The entrance for the Mailman Hollywood building is the last entrance before College Avenue. Make your first right after passing the "End of School Zone Sign" into the entrance for the Maltz Building, at the stop sign, turn left and make a right into the parking lot.

Transportation Options

Airport Shuttle

GO Airport Shuttle is South Florida's exclusive on-demand shared ride and private car service. They are the official airport transportation provider for the Fort Lauderdale-Hollywood International Airport (FLL). They offer Shared Ride Shuttles, Private Cars, Private Vans, Private SUV's, Charters and Executive Service for airport arrivals. Go Airport Shuttle offer discounts for college students.
