Tech tips

How to join our RI Zoom sessions

Each RI session has an 11-digit number called a **Meeting ID** that will be required to join. Find the number on the RI schedule under Zoom Meeting ID.

See below for quick tips on joining the meeting from a computer, your mobile app, or telephonically.

Important: For participation confirmation purposes, when you join the meeting, make sure the display name is your actual first and last name. The Zoom sessions may have a waiting room function and your name is important so the session organizer can let you into the meeting.

On your computer or on your mobile device using the Zoom application:

To join a Zoom meeting on a computer or mobile device, download the Zoom app from Zoom download center: https://zoom.us/download

- Open the Zoom desktop (or mobile) application
- Click Join a Meeting
- Enter the Meeting ID from the RI schedule
- Please make sure the display name is your actual first and last name. Rename if needed.
- Select if you would like to connect audio and/or video
- Click Join

Telephonically, from a landline or mobile phone:

To join via telephone, you will need the teleconferencing number. Find the best number to call based on your location: https://zoom.us/zoomconference, e.g.

- o United States of America
 - +1 929 205 6099 (New York)
 - +1 312 626 6799 (Chicago)
 - +1 669 900 6833 (San Jose)
 - +1 346 248 7799 (Houston)
- On your phone, dial the teleconferencing number.
- Enter the Meeting ID from the RI schedule when prompted using your dial pad.

On your computer, from the browser:

- Open your browser, e.g., Chrome, and go to https://zoom.us/join
- Enter the Meeting ID from the RI schedule
- Make sure the display name is your actual First and Last name. Rename if needed.
- Select if you would like to connect audio and/or video
- Click **Join**
 - If this is your first time joining from a browser, you may be asked to open Zoom or the Zoom installer package. Follow prompts to open/install.

Bonus tip: Notice that you can just swap the digits in this URL with the **Meeting ID** to join a meeting: https://zoom.us/j/MeetingID
