

Film Festival Guidelines

- Films should be 5-10 minutes in length. Films that don't adhere to these length requirements will be disqualified.
- The director for each film must be a current NSU undergraduate student; however, the actors and other crew members don't need to be NSU students.
- You must secure a faculty sponsor for your project; the faculty sponsor must approve your abstract before you complete the USS application.
- You must clearly cite the influences on your work in the film credits and written abstract. If you borrow any paradigm or technique from a specific film, you should make that explicit.
- You may submit only one film per year to the annual Film Festival.
- You're responsible for attending the screening of your film during the symposium.

The festival organizers may hold an organizational workshop. Workshop topics may include tips for writing scripts, recruiting actors, camera work, editing, and submitting abstracts to the USS.
